

### **SUMMARY CARE RECORD (SCR)**

This is where core summary information is uploaded to the spine unless a patient opts-out. The information uploaded will contain medication, allergies and adverse reaction; if patient consents additional information can also be uploaded. Summary Care Records can only be viewed in organisations by staff with relevant access; in emergency situations patients may be asked for their consent to view their SCR. There is an opt-out form that patients can fill in and if registering with a doctor you will be given an SCR form to complete.

### **ENHANCED DATA SHARING MODEL (eDSM)**

The eDSM allow staff who are involved with the patient's care to have full access to the patient's medical records; these include places such as Out of Hours, 111 and other care settings.

The patient's permission is sought at each organisation to share out i.e. make their medical record available to be viewed by other services and to share in i.e. consent for their records to be viewed. It is the patient's choice as to who sees their record and they will be asked the shared in/out question at every care setting. Sharing forms are available from Reception.
